PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Act, Indiana Code §4-21.5-1 et seq. and Indiana Code §27-10-3-8, hereby gives notice to Bridgette Marie Campbell (“Applicant”) of the following Administrative Order:

1. Applicant filed an application for licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance (“Commissioner”) on July 29, 2015. Following a review of materials submitted by Applicant in support of her application and further investigation by the Department, the Commissioner, being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that she is not qualified for licensure under Indiana Code §27-10-3-8(a)(3).
2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code §27-10-3-1 and Indiana Code §27-10-3-3.
3. Indiana Code §27-10-3-8(a)(3) provides, in part, that the Commissioner shall deny an Indiana Bail Agent license for material misstatement, misrepresentation, or fraud in obtaining the license.

4. Following a review of materials submitted by Applicant in support of her application, the Commissioner finds that Applicant failed to disclose two open misdemeanor cases filed against her in Onslow County, North Carolina for "Worthless Checks". By having, and failing to disclose the pending charges against her, Applicant made material misstatements on her application, grounds for denial of her license application under Indiana Codes §27-10-3-8(a)(3).
5. Indiana Code §27-10-3-10 provides, in part, that the applicant for license as a bail agent whose application has been denied may appeal to the circuit court of the county from which the bail agent applied for the license. The appeal shall be heard de novo.
6. Indiana Code §27-10-3-1(e) provides that the failure of the applicant to secure approval of the commissioner shall not preclude the applicant from applying as many times as the applicant desires. However, an applicant's application may not be considered by the commissioner within one (1) year subsequent to the date upon which the commissioner denied the applicant's last application.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED pursuant to Indiana Code §27-10-3-8.
