
IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Commissioner of Insurance:

1. Respondent shall pay an administrative fine of two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) within thirty (30) days after the Commissioner signs the Final Order, for her failure to

disclose a 1998 monetary penalty issued by the Texas Department of Insurance on her application for licensure.

2. The Department agrees to accept this agreement as full resolution of this matter.

AGREED ENTRY

This Agreed Entry is executed by and between the Enforcement Division of the Indiana Department of Insurance (“Department”), by counsel, Brigitte R. Collier, and Alma Padilla (“Applicant”) to resolve all issues in the above-captioned cause number. This Agreed Entry is subject to the review and approval of Stephen W. Robertson, Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance.

WHEREAS, on September 20, 2015, Applicant submitted an application to the Department for a Nonresident Producer license;

WHEREAS, on said license application, Applicant failed to disclose a May 21, 1998 monetary penalty issued by the Texas Department of Insurance;

WHEREAS, the Applicant’s conduct constitutes a violation of Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1), which states that a producer shall not provide incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application;

WHEREAS, the Department and Applicant (collectively, the "Parties") desire to resolve this matter without the necessity of a hearing.

IT IS, THEREFORE, NOW AGREED by and between the parties as follows:

1. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the subject matter and the Parties to this Agreed Entry.
2. This Agreed Entry is executed voluntarily by the Parties.
3. Applicant voluntarily and freely waives the right to a public hearing on the issues in this matter.
4. Applicant voluntarily and freely waives the right to judicial review of this matter.
5. Applicant shall pay an administrative fine in the amount of two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) within thirty (30) days after the Commissioner signs the Final Order adopting this Agreed Entry.
6. Provided no other issues arise, once said administrative fine is paid, Applicant's application for licensure shall be granted.
7. The Department agrees to accept Applicant's compliance with this agreement as full satisfaction of this matter.
8. Applicant has carefully read and examined this agreement and fully understand its terms.
9. Applicant has entered into this agreement freely, and have not been subject to duress, threat or undue influence.
10. Should this Agreed Entry not be accepted by the Commissioner, it is agreed that presentation to and consideration of this Agreed Entry by the Commissioner shall not unfairly or illegally prejudice the Commissioner from further participation in or resolution of these proceedings.

11. Applicant is aware that failure to comply with any of the terms of this agreement will result in the matter being set for a hearing.

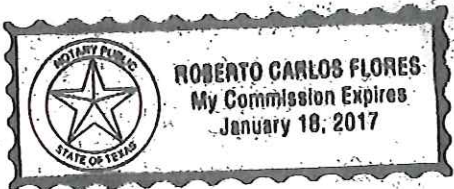
