**PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER**  
**AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL**

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Act, Indiana Code §4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Jeffrey M. Jarnigo (“Applicant”) of the following Administrative Order:

1. Applicant filed an application for licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance (“Commissioner”) on October 28, 2015.
2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-8 and Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12.
3. Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(b) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer’s license for demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness, or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business in Indiana or elsewhere; for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application; and for having an insurance producer’s license or its equivalent, denied, suspended, or revoked in any other state, province, district or territory.

4. Following a review of materials submitted by Applicant in support of his application, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that he has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12 due to his December 14, 2012 conviction for Violating a Domestic Abuse Injunction, a Misdemeanor, his May 31, 2013 Wisconsin license denial, and his failure to disclose this information in his application for licensure.
  
5. Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the applicant or licensee may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the applicant's application or non renewal of the licensee's license is mailed, make written demand to the commissioner for a hearing before the commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the commissioner's action.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** that the Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED pursuant to Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(b).
