Gendron ("Respondent"), to resolve all issues in the above-captioned cause number. This Agreed Entry is subject to the review and approval of Stephen W. Robertson, Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance.

WHEREAS, Respondent is a licensed Nonresident Independent Adjuster, holding license number 885457;

WHEREAS, Respondent submitted an application for a Nonresident Producer's license on June 14, 2013;

WHEREAS, on said application, Respondent failed to disclose a 1998 Louisiana misdemeanor conviction for theft and a 2000 Louisiana misdemeanor conviction for trespassing;

WHEREAS, the Respondent's conduct is a violation of Indiana Code § 27-1-28-18(b)(1), which states that an independent adjuster shall not provide incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application;

WHEREAS, the Department and Respondent (collectively, the "Parties") desire to resolve this matter without the necessity of a hearing.

IT IS, THEREFORE, NOW AGREED by and between the parties as follows:

- The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the subject matter and the Parties to this Agreed Entry.
- 2. This Agreed Entry is executed voluntarily by the Parties.
- 3. Respondent voluntarily and freely waives the right to a public hearing on the issues in this matter.
- 4. Respondent voluntarily and freely waives the right to judicial review of this matter.
- 5. Respondent shall pay an administrative fine of Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) to the Department within thirty (30) days after the Commissioner's Final Order adopting this Agreed Entry.
- 6. Should additional violations manifest, this fine shall be in addition to any administrative actions for the new violation.
- 7. The Department agrees to accept Respondent's compliance with this agreement as full satisfaction of this matter.
- Respondent has carefully read and examined this agreement and fully understands its terms.
- Respondent has entered into this agreement freely, and has not been subject to duress, threat or undue influence.
- Should this Agreed Entry not be accepted by the Commissioner, it is agreed that presentation to and consideration of this Agreed Entry by the Commissioner shall

not unfairly or illegally prejudice the Commissioner from further participation in or resolution of these proceedings.

11. Respondent is aware that failure to comply with any of the terms of this agreement will result in the matter being set for a hearing.
