ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NOTICE OF NONRENEWAL OF LICENSE

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 <u>et seq</u>. and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Adelo Escobar, ("Respondent") of the following Administrative Order:

- 1. Respondent, a resident of Arizona, is a licensed insurance producer under license number 563715.
 - 2. Respondent has been licensed in the state of Indiana since October, 2010.
 - 3. Respondent's non-resident producer's license expires on April 30, 2016.
- 4. On August 30, 2012, the Department received notification of administrative actions on license 563715. Administrative actions were taken in Georgia, South Dakota, Massachusetts and Colorado.
 - 5. Respondent never notified the Department of these administrative actions.

6. Indiana Code 27-1-15.6-17(a) states, in part, that producers must report any

administrative actions taken against them in another jurisdiction within (30) days of the final

disposition of the matter

7. Indiana Code 27-1-15.6-12(b)(2)(A) states, in part, that the Commissioner may

refuse to renew an insurance producer's license for violating insurance law. Indiana Code 27-1-

15.6-17(a) is such an insurance law.

8. Indiana Code 27-1-15.6-12(b)(9) states, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse

to renew an insurance producer's license for having an insurance producer license, or its

equivalent, denied, suspended, or revoked in any other state.

9. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) requires the Commissioner to notify a licensee of

the reason for the nonrenewal of his license. This Order serves as that notice.

10. The Commissioner further notifies Respondent that, pursuant to Indiana Code §

27-1-15.6-12(d), Respondent may, within sixty thee (63) days of receiving this Order, make a

written demand upon the Commissioner for a hearing to determine the reasonableness of this

action. Such a hearing shall be held within thirty (30) days from the date of receipt of

Respondent's written demand.

WHEREFORE, based on the foregoing, the Commissioner of Insurance hereby notifies

Respondent that his license shall not be renewed for being subject to administrative actions in

the states of Georgia, South Dakota, Massachusetts, and Colorado and for failing to notify the

Department of these administrative actions as required by Indiana Code 27-1-15.6-17(a).
