**FINAL ORDER**

The Indiana Department of Insurance (“Department”) and Rebecca Koontz (“Respondent”), a licensed resident Indiana insurance producer, signed an Agreed Entry which purports to resolve all issues involved in the action by the Department regarding Respondent’s license, and which has been submitted to the Commissioner of Insurance (the “Commissioner”) for approval.

The Commissioner, after reviewing the Agreed Entry, finds it has been entered into fairly and without fraud, duress or undue influence, and is fair and equitable between the parties. The Commissioner hereby incorporates the Agreed Entry as if fully set forth herein, and approves and adopts in full the Agreed Entry as a resolution of this matter.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Commissioner of Insurance:

1. Respondent shall pay a fine in the amount of Five Hundred Dollars and no/100 (\$500.00), payable within sixty days (60) from the date of this Final Order for providing a rebate of premium in violation of Indiana Code § 27-4-1-4(a)(8).

**AGREED ENTRY**

This Agreed Entry is executed by and between the Enforcement Division of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Department"), by counsel, Joshua D. Harrison, and Respondent Rebecca Koontz ("Respondent"), an Indiana resident insurance producer. This Agreed Entry is subject to the review and approval of the Commissioner of the Department.

WHEREAS, Respondent is a resident of Indiana;

WHEREAS, Respondent is a licensed Indiana resident insurance producer, holding license number 555743;

WHEREAS, on or about December 15, 2014, Respondent gave Dennis and Veronica Maggioli ("Maggiolis") Three Hundred Twenty-two Dollars and no/100 (\$322.00) as a refund of premium paid to Humana Insurance Company for the purchase of a Humana Choice PPO plan purchased from Respondent;

WHEREAS, the Department alleges Respondent's conduct, as stated herein, is in violation of Indiana Code 27-4-1-4(a)(8); and,

WHEREAS, the Department and Respondent desire to settle the issues without a hearing.

IT IS, THEREFORE, NOW AGREED by and between the parties as follows:

1. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the subject matter of and the parties to this Agreed Entry.
2. This Agreed Entry is executed voluntarily by the parties.
3. Respondent voluntarily and freely waives her right to a public hearing.
4. Respondent voluntarily and freely waives her right to petition for judicial review of this agreement and the Commissioner's Final Order.
5. Respondent shall to pay an administrative fine in the amount of Five Hundred Dollars and no/100 (\$500.00), made payable to the Indiana Department of Insurance, due within sixty days (60) from the date of the Commissioner's Final Order in this matter.
6. The Department agrees to accept Respondent's compliance with the terms of this agreement as full resolution of this matter.
7. Should this Agreed Entry not be accepted by the Commissioner, it is agreed that presentation to and consideration of this Agreed Entry by the Commissioner shall not unfairly or illegally prejudice the Commissioner from further participation in or resolution of these proceedings.
