ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
NOTICE OF NONRENEWAL OF LICENSE

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 *et seq.*, and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Myrle Salomon ("Respondent") of the following Administrative Order:

1. Respondent, a resident of Indiana, is a licensed insurance producer holding license number 856696, since December, 2012 ("Respondent's license").
2. Respondent's license expired on August 31, 2015.
3. On October 9, 2015, the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") mailed Respondent a certified letter requesting a list of appointments and a written response to a complaint received by the Department. The letter was delivered on October 13, 2015, by the US Postal Service to 433 S. Grange Hall Road, Hanover, Indiana 47243.
4. Respondent has failed to provide a list of appointments within ten (10) days as requested by the Commissioner and as required by Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(g).


5. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(2)(A) provides that "The commissioner may levy a civil penalty, place an insurance producer on probation, suspend an insurance producer's license, revoke and insurance producer's license for a period of years, permanently revoke an insurance producer's license, or refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer license, or take any combination of these actions, for ... violating an insurance law;" .

6. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that when the Commissioner refuses to renew a license, the Commissioner shall notify the Respondent, in writing, of the reasons for the nonrenewal. This Order serves as that notice.

7. The Commissioner further notifies Respondent that, pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d), Respondent may, within sixty-three (63) days of the mailing of this Order, make a written demand upon the Commissioner for a hearing to determine the reasonableness of this action. Such a hearing shall be held within thirty (30) days from the date of receipt of Respondent's written demand.

WHEREFORE, based on the foregoing, the Commissioner of Insurance hereby notifies Respondent that **Respondent's license shall not be renewed** for failure to provide a list of company appointments in accordance with Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(g).
