PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code §4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Kristian Baso ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:

- Applicant filed an application for licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana
 Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") on February 09, 2016.
- 2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-8 and Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12.
- 3. Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(b) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer license for having been convicted of a felony, and for having an insurance producer's license or its equivalent, denied, suspended, or revoked in any other state, province, district or territory.
- 4. Following a review of materials submitted by Applicant in support of his application, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that he has not fully

met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12 due to his

October 25, 1991 New York felony conviction for attempted robbery, his August 05,

2015 license revocation by the California Department of Insurance, his January 06, 2016

license revocation by the Kentucky Department of Insurance, and the November 24, 2015

issuance of an Order and Notice of Nonrenewal of License by the Indiana Department of

Insurance.

6. Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the applicant or licensee may, not more than

sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the applicant's application or non renewal

of the licensee's license is mailed, make written demand to the commissioner for a

hearing before the commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the commissioner's

action.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED

pursuant to Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(b), due to having an insurance producer's license

revoked or denied a renewal and for having been convicted of a felony.
