PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code §4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Travis Gillespie ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:

- Applicant filed an application for licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana
 Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") on April 01, 2016.
- 2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-6 and Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12.
- 3. Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(b) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer license for using fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest practices, or demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness, or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business in Indiana or elsewhere.
- 4. Following a review of materials submitted by Applicant in support of his application, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that he has not fully

met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12 due his August 31, 2004 Wisconsin conviction for Sex with Child Age 16 or Older, a Class A Misdemeanor.

Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the applicant or licensee may, not more than 5. sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the applicant's application or non renewal of the licensee's license is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED pursuant to Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(b), due to his misdemeanor conviction for sex with a child age 16 or older.
