**PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER**  
**AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL**

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code §4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Corey W. Combs ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:

1. Applicant filed an application for resident licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") on January 27, 2016.
2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-6 and Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12.
3. Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(b) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue an insurance producer license for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application.
4. Following a review of materials submitted by Applicant in support of his application, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that he has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12 due to his April 30, 2015 convictions of two (2) counts of Criminal Mischief, Class B

Misdemeanors; his January 05, 2006 conviction of Invasion of Privacy, a Class A Misdemeanor; his August 04, 2005 conviction of Pointing a Firearm, a Class A Misdemeanor; and for his failure to disclose all of the convictions in his application for Indiana licensure.

6. Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby **DENIED** pursuant to Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(b) for his failure to disclose his criminal history in a license application.
