PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code §4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Holly L. Kubicki ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:

1. Applicant filed an application for resident licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") on June 10, 2016.
2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-6 and Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12.
3. Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(b) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue an insurance producer license for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application, and for having been convicted of a felony.
4. Following a review of materials submitted by Applicant in support of her application, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that she has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12 due to her

January 15, 2009 convictions for two (2) counts of Trespass, Class A Misdemeanors; her December 07, 2009 convictions for two (2) counts of Receiving Stolen Property, Class D Felonies; her May 11, 2010 conviction for Illegal Consumption, a Class C Misdemeanor; and for her failure to disclose all of the convictions in her application for Indiana licensure.

6. Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED pursuant to Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12 (b) for her failure to disclose her criminal history in a license application, and for having been convicted of a felony.
