## PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code §4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Anthony Maresca ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:

- Applicant submitted an application for licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana
   Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") on August 8, 2016.
- 2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-8 and Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12.
- 3. Indiana Còde §27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer license for having been convicted of a felony.
- 4. Following a review of materials which were submitted in the application, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that he has not fully met the requirements of licensure, as stated by Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(b)(6), due to

having been convicted on May 14, 2009 in Charlotte County, Florida for Sale or Delivery of Cocaine, a Second Degree Felony, and Possession of Cocaine, a Third Degree Felony.

5. Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the Applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the applicant's application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED pursuant to Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(b)(6), due to convictions on May 14, 2009 in Charlotte County, Florida for Sale or Delivery of Cocaine, a Second Degree Felony, and Possession of Cocaine, a Third Degree Felony.
