PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL


The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code §4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Michelle Stressing ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:

1. Applicant filed an application for resident licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") on July 11, 2016.
2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-6 and Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12. Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(b) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue an insurance producer license for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application, and for failing to pay state income tax or to comply with an administrative or court order directing payment of state income tax.

3. Following a review of materials submitted by Applicant in support of her application, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that she has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Codes §27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) and §27-1-15.6-12(b)(14) due to her failure to disclose in an application for licensure, her April 20, 2010 Indiana conviction of Criminal Mischief, a Class A Misdemeanor; her May 01, 2013 Indiana conviction of Possession of Paraphernalia, a Class A Misdemeanor; and her failure to pay state income tax.
6. Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the applicant's application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED pursuant to Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(b), due to her failure to disclose her misdemeanor convictions and delinquent state income tax in an application for licensure.
