PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code §4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to John Solfronk ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:

- 1. Applicant submitted an application for licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana

 Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") on September 9, 2016.
- 2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-6 and Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12.
- 3. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) states that the Commissioner may deny a license application for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application.
- 4. Following a review of materials which were submitted in the application, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that he has not fully met the requirements of licensure, as stated by Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(b)(1), due to

his failure to disclose having been convicted of multiple misdemeanors in Monroe County, Indiana on August 16, 2011. Applicant was convicted of Unauthorized Entry of a Motor Vehicle, Resisting Law Enforcement, Illegal Consumption of an Alcoholic Beverage, and Possession of Paraphernalia.

5. Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the Applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the applicant's application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED pursuant to Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(b)(1), for failure to report several misdemeanor convictions on application for licensure.
