PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code §4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Sunjoi Bradshaw ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:

- Applicant filed an application for resident licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana
 Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") on October 04, 2016.
- 2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-6 and Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12.
- 3. Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(b) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue an insurance producer license for having been convicted of a felony, and for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application.
- 4. Following a review of materials submitted by Applicant in support of her application, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that she has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) and

Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) due to her August 12, 2004 Indiana conviction of Theft; Receiving Stolen Property, Class D Felony, and her failure to disclose it on her application for licensure.

6. Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED pursuant to Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(b) for having been convicted of a felony and for failing to disclose it on her application for licensure.
