AGREED ENTRY

This Agreed Entry is executed by and between the Enforcement Division of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Department"), by counsel, Cathleen Nine-Altevogt, and Andrea M. Black ("Applicant"), to resolve all issues in the above-captioned cause number. This Agreed Entry is subject to the review and approval of Stephen W. Robertson, Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner").

WHEREAS, on November 3, 2016, Applicant filed a resident application for licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner").

WHEREAS, before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-6 and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12;

WHEREAS, Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(b) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer license for using fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest practices, or demonstrating incompetence or untrustworthiness;

WHEREAS, following a review of materials submitted by Applicant in support of her application, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that she has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12 based on her September 26, 2008 Virginia conviction of Class 1 Misdemeanor for Embezzlement of less than \$200, and;

WHEREAS, the Department and Applicant (collectively, the "Parties") desire to resolve this matter without the necessity of a hearing.

IT IS, THEREFORE, NOW AGREED by and between the parties as follows:

- The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the subject matter and the Parties to this Agreed Entry.
- 2. This Agreed Entry is executed voluntarily by the Parties.
- Applicant voluntarily and freely waives the right to a public hearing on the issues in this
 matter.
- 4. Applicant voluntarily and freely waives the right to judicial review of this matter.
- 5. Applicant's license shall be granted and placed on probation for a period of twenty-four (24) months, during which time Applicant must report any criminal charges to the Department within ten (10) days from the date of the charges being filed. Additionally, during the probationary period, any violations of Title 27 will result in the Department seeking immediate revocation of Applicant's license.
- 6. Should additional violations manifest, the revocation shall be in addition to any administrative actions for the new violation.
- The Department agrees to accept Applicant's compliance with this agreement as full satisfaction of this matter.

- 8. Applicant has carefully read and examined this agreement and fully understands its terms.
- 9. Applicant has entered into this agreement freely, and has not been subject to duress, threat or undue influence.
- 10. Should this Agreed Entry not be accepted by the Commissioner, it is agreed that presentation to and consideration of this Agreed Entry by the Commissioner shall not unfairly or illegally prejudice the Commissioner from further participation in or resolution of these proceedings.
- 11. Applicant is aware that failure to comply with any of the terms of this agreement will result in the matter being set for a hearing.
