PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code §4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Michael Timothy McMahon (“Applicant”) of the following Administrative Order:


1. Applicant filed a nonresident application for licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance (“Commissioner”) on December 15, 2016.
2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-8 and Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12.
3. Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(b) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer license for having an insurance producer license denied, suspended or revoked in another state.
4. Following a review of materials submitted by Applicant in support of his application, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that he has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12 based on four

(4) previous administrative actions. Applicant's license was revoked by the State of Louisiana on November 10, 2009, by the State of Virginia on April 15, 2010 and by the State of Delaware on November 9, 2010. Applicant's application for licensure was denied by the State of Indiana on September 21, 2015.

5. The Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that he has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12 due to his failure to disclose the license revocations by Louisiana, Virginia and Delaware, and the license denial by Indiana in his application for licensure.
6. Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the Applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the applicant's application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED pursuant to Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(b).
