**PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER**  
**AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL**

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code §4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Gemma Miller (“Applicant”) of the following Administrative Order:

1. Applicant filed an application for resident licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance (“Commissioner”) on December 15, 2016.
2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-6 and Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12.
3. Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) provides that the Commissioner may refuse to issue or an insurance producer license for using fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest practices, or demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness, or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business in Indiana or elsewhere. Following a review of materials submitted by Applicant in support of their application, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that she has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) due to her pending May 01, 2016 Shelby County

Indiana charges of Forgery with Intent to Defraud, a Level 6 Felony; Obtaining a Controlled Substance by Fraud or Deceit, a Level 6 Felony; Theft, a Class A Misdemeanor; her pending August 12, 2016 charge of Theft, a Class A Misdemeanor; and her pending August 16, 2016 charge of Identity Deception, a Level 6 Felony.

5. Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED pursuant to Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) for using fraudulent, coercive, and dishonest practices, and demonstrating untrustworthiness.
