PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code §4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Joseph Morrissey ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:


1. Applicant filed an application for licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") on January 9, 2017.
2. Before approving a resident producer application, the Commissioner must find that the Applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-6 and Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12.
3. Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(b) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer license for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application, or for having been convicted of a felony.

4. Following a review of materials submitted by Applicant in support of his application, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that he has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) due to his failure to disclose in his application for licensure the following convictions:
 - a. Public Indecency/Indecent Exposure, Class A Misdemeanor - September 8, 2005;
 - b. Public Intoxication, Class B Misdemeanor - March 3, 2008;
 - c. Public Intoxication, Class B Misdemeanor - March 24, 2008;
 - d. Public Intoxication, Class B Misdemeanor - December 1, 2008;
 - e. Operating a Vehicle While Intoxicated, OWI with Prior OWI within 5 Years, Class D Felony - December 4, 2009; and,
 - f. Criminal Trespass, Class A Misdemeanor - October 28, 2010.
5. Following a review of materials submitted by Applicant in support of his application, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that he has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) due to his December 4, 2009 Class D Felony conviction of Operating a Vehicle While Intoxicated, OWI with Prior OWI within 5 Years.
6. Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the applicant's application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Applicant's request for licensure is hereby
DENIED pursuant to Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(b).
