PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Garrett Wright (“Applicant”) of the following Administrative Order:

1. Applicant submitted an application for licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance (“Commissioner”) on February 15, 2017.
2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-8 and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12.
3. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) states that the Commissioner may deny an applicant for using fraudulent, coercive, dishonest practices, or demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness, or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business in Indiana and elsewhere.

4. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(9) states that the Commissioner may deny an applicant for having an insurance producer license, or its equivalent, denied, suspended, or revoked in any other state, province, district, or territory.
5. Following a review of materials which were submitted in the application, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that he has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(9) for having been convicted of misdemeanor aggravated assault/domestic battery on August 13, 2014 in Maricopa County, Arizona, and for having failed to report a producer license denial in the State of Arizona on May 11, 1994.
6. Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the Applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the applicant's application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) and § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(9), due to misdemeanor conviction of aggravated assault/domestic violence and failing to report a license denial from the State of Arizona on his application for licensure.
