AGREED ENTRY

This Agreed Entry is executed by the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Department"), by counsel, Claire Szpara, and Associates Title, Inc. ("Respondent"), a non-resident title insurance agency licensed to do business in Indiana, to resolve all issues in the above captioned matter. This Agreed Entry is subject to the review and approval of Stephen W. Robertson, Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner").

WHEREAS, Respondent is a non-resident title insurance agency holding license number 658820;

WHEREAS, Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(4) states the commissioner may levy a civil penalty for any of the following causes: improperly withholding, misappropriating, or converting any monies or property received in the course of doing insurance business;

WHEREAS, the Respondent overcharged premium fees on five (5) title insurance policies;

WHEREAS, the Respondent overcharged recording fees on ten (10) title insurance policies;

WHEREAS, Indiana Code § 27-7-3.6-7(a) states a person that purchases a title insurance policy shall pay to the title insurer that issues the title insurance policy a fee of five dollars (\$5) as a fee for the title insurance enforcement fund at the time of payment for the title insurance policy, known as Title Insurance Enforcement Fund Fee ("TIEFF");

WHEREAS; the Respondent did not charge TIEFF on eight (8) title insurance policies;

WHEREAS, Ryan P. Phillips, Vice President of Associates Title, Inc., is authorized to act on behalf of Respondent and obligate it to perform in accordance with this agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Department and Respondent (collectively, the "Parties") desire to resolve their differences and settle their issues without incurring the time and expense of a hearing.

IT IS, THEREFORE, NOW AGREED by and between the Parties as follows:

- 1. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the subject matter and the Parties in this administrative action.
- 2. This Agreed Entry is executed voluntarily by the Parties.
- Respondent voluntarily and freely waives the right to a public hearing in this
 matter.

4. Respondent voluntarily and freely waives the right to judicial review of this matter.

Respondent has refunded consumers eight hundred ninety-nine dollars (\$899).

6. Respondent agrees to pay an administrative penalty in the amount of one thousand

one hundred dollars (\$1,100) to the Department within thirty days (30) after the

Commissioner signs the Final Order approving this Agreed Entry.

7. The Department agrees to accept Respondent's compliance with the agreement

herein as full satisfaction of this matter.

8. Respondent has carefully read and examined this agreement and fully understands

its terms.

9. Respondent has entered into this agreement freely, and has not been subject to

duress, threat or undue influence.

10. Should this Agreed Entry not be accepted by the Commissioner, it is agreed that

presentation to and consideration of this Agreed Entry by the Commissioner shall

not unfairly or illegally prejudice the Commissioner from further participation in

or resolution of these proceedings.

11. Respondent is aware that failure to comply with any term of this agreement will

result in the matter being set for hearing.
