PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code §4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Jason Smith ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:

- Applicant filed an application for nonresident licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") on February 7, 2017.
- 2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-8 and Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12.
- 3. Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) provides that the Commissioner may refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer license due to having been convicted of a felony.
- 4. Following a review of materials submitted by Applicant in support of their application, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that he has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(b)(6), due to his August 25, 2004 Idaho conviction of Sexual Battery of a Minor Child Sixteen Years of Age, a Felony.

5. Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED pursuant to Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) for having been convicted of a felony.
