The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code §4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Delicia L. Rainey ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:

- Applicant filed an application for resident licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana
 Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") on March 21, 2017.
- 2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-6 and Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12.
- 3. Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) provides that the Commissioner may refuse to issue an insurance producer license for having been convicted of a felony. Following a review of materials submitted by Applicant in support of her application, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that she has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) due to her January 05, 2012 Texas conviction of Possession with Intent to Deliver Cocaine, a First Degree Felony.

Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the applicant may, not more than sixty-three 4. (63) days after notice of denial of the application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED pursuant to Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) due to her felony conviction.
