PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5 *et seq.* and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Nancy Garcia ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:

1. Applicant submitted an application for licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") on March 13, 2017.
2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-6 and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12.
3. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) provides that the Commissioner may refuse to issue an insurance producer license for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application.
4. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) provides that the Commissioner may refuse to issue an insurance producer license for having been convicted of a felony.

5. Following a review of materials which were submitted in the application, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that she has not fully met the requirements of licensure, as stated by Indiana Codes § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) and § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6), due to having failed to report on the application for licensure a felony conviction on August 11, 2008 of operating a vehicle causing serious bodily injury in Elkhart County, Indiana
6. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the Applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the applicant's application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED pursuant to Indiana Codes § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) and § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6), due to Applicant's failure to report a felony conviction for operating a vehicle causing serious bodily injury on her application for licensure.
