PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance ("Department"), pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Alphonse SeanPaul Derouaux ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:

1. Applicant filed an application for licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") on May 11, 2017.
2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the Applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-8 and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12.
3. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) provides that the Commissioner may refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer license for providing incorrect, incomplete or materially untrue information in a license application.

4. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-8(a)(1) provides a nonresident person shall receive a nonresident producer license if the person is currently licensed as a resident and in good standing in the person's home state.
5. Following a review of public records, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant he has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12 based on Applicant's failure to disclose a December 13, 2006 misdemeanor public intoxication conviction and an August 16, 2010 misdemeanor possession of marijuana conviction. Applicant has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-8 for failing to have a home state license in good standing.
6. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the Applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the Applicant's application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-8(a)(1).
