PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act § 4-21.5 *et seq.* and Indiana Code § 27-1-28-18, hereby gives notice to Jesse H. Cathcart ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:

- Applicant filed an application for licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana
 Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") on May 23, 2017.
- 2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code § 27-1-28-12 and Indiana Code § 27-1-28-18.
- 3. Indiana Code § 27-1-28-18(b) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue an independent adjusters license for any of the following: using fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest practices, or demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness, or financial irresponsibility, in the conduct of insurance business, or for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application.
- 4. Following a review of materials submitted by Applicant in support of his application, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that he has not fully

met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code § 27-1-28-18(b)(8) due to his July 15, 2003 and November 18, 2003 convictions of Check Deception, both Class A Misdemeanors. Furthermore, Applicant failed to disclose his convictions on his application for licensure, in violation of Indiana Code § 27-1-28-18(b)(1).

5. Indiana Code § 27-1-28-18(c) provides that the applicant or licensee may, not more than thirty (30) days after receiving the Commissioner's notice of refusal, make written demand upon the Commissioner for a hearing to determine the reasonableness of the refusal.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-28-18(b)(8) and § 27-1-28-18(b)(1) due to his misdemeanor convictions and his failure to disclose them on his license application.
