AMENDED FINAL ORDER



The Commissioner, after reviewing the Agreed Entry, finds it has been entered into fairly and without fraud, duress or undue influence, and is fair and equitable between the parties. The Commissioner hereby incorporates the Agreed Entry as if fully set forth herein, and approves and adopts in full the Agreed Entry as a resolution of this matter.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Commissioner of Insurance:

1. Respondent's Indiana insurance producer license shall be revoked for a period of three (3) years, effective immediately after the signing of this Final Order.
2. The Department agrees to accept this agreement as full resolution of this matter.



AGREED ENTRY

This Agreed Entry is executed by and between the Enforcement Division of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Department"), by counsel Claire Szpara, and Briana Haught ("Respondent"), a resident insurance producer licensed to do business in Indiana, to resolve all issues in the above captioned matter. This Agreed Entry is subject to the review and approval of Stephen W. Robertson, Commissioner for the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner").

WHEREAS, Respondent is a licensed Indiana resident insurance producer, holding license number 3181605;

WHEREAS, Respondent failed to disclose to the Department her pending felony charge on her initial application for licensure in August 2016;

WHEREAS, Respondent plead guilty to Conspiracy to Provide False Information During the Purchase of Firearms, a Federal felony, on May 10, 2017;

WHEREAS, Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) states the Commissioner may levy a civil penalty, revoke a producer's license, or take any combination of these actions, against a producer for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete or materially untrue information in a license application;

WHEREAS, Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) states the Commissioner may levy a civil penalty, revoke a producer's license, or take any combination of these actions, against a producer for having been convicted of a felony;

WHEREAS, Respondent has been advised of her right to an administrative hearing before a Department administrative law judge;


WHEREAS, the Department and Respondent (collectively, the "Parties") desire to resolve their differences and settle the issues without the necessity of an administrative hearing.

IT IS THEREFORE NOW AGREED by and between the Parties as follows:

1. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the subject matter and the Parties in this Agreed Entry.
2. This Agreed Entry is executed voluntarily by the Parties.
3. Respondent voluntarily and freely waives her right to a public hearing on this matter.
4. Respondent voluntarily and freely waives her right to judicial review of this matter.
5. Respondent agrees to revocation of her Indiana producer's license for a period of three (3) years, immediately effective after the Commissioner's signature adopting this Agreed Entry. Respondent may reapply for licensure after the three (3) year time period.
6. The Department agrees to accept Respondent's compliance with the terms of this Agreed Entry herein as full satisfaction of this matter.

7. Respondent has carefully read and examined this Agreed Entry and fully understands its terms.
8. Respondent has entered into this Agreed Entry freely, and has not been subject to duress, threat or undue influence.
9. Should this Agreed Entry not be accepted by the Commissioner, it is agreed that presentation to and consideration of this Agreed Entry by the Commissioner shall not unfairly or illegally prejudice the Commissioner from further participation in or resolution of these proceedings.
10. Respondent is aware that failure to comply with any term of this agreement will result in the matter being set for hearing.


