PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Jasen Benton ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:

- Applicant filed an application for nonresident licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") on May 16, 2017.
- 2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-8 and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12.
- 3. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue an insurance producer license for having an insurance producer's license or its equivalent, denied, suspended, or revoked in any other state, province, district or territory and for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application. Following a review of materials submitted by Applicant in support of his application, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that he has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-

12(b)(9) due to his administrative actions issued by the Wisconsin Office of the Commissioner of Insurance: a September 27, 1991 license denial, an October 12, 2001 license denial, and an April 07, 2008 license revocation, and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) due to his failure to disclose his administrative actions on his application for

licensure.

4. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the applicant may, not more than sixty-three

(63) days after notice of denial of the application is mailed, make written demand to the

Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of

the Commissioner's action.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED

pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(9) and § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) due to his three (3)

administrative actions and his failure to disclose them on his application for licensure.
