PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code §4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Robert Cinnante ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:

- Applicant filed an application for nonresident licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") on June 22, 2017.
- 2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-8 and Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12.
- 3. Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) provides that the Commissioner may refuse to issue an insurance producer license for having been convicted of a felony.
- 4. Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) provides that the Commissioner may refuse to issue an insurance producer license for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application.

5. Following a review of materials submitted by Applicant in support of his application, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that he has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(b)(6), due his January 24, 1989 federal felony conviction, and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) for his failure to disclose his March 03, 2009 Consent Order issued by the New York Department

of Financial Services.

6. Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED pursuant to Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) for having been convicted of a felony, and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) for failing to disclose an administrative action in a license application.
