PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Marjorie Garner ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:

- Applicant submitted an application for licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana
 Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") on July 17, 2017.
- 2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-8 and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12.
- 3. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) states that the Commissioner may deny a license application for having a felony conviction.
- 4. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) states that the Commissioner may deny a license application for using fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest practices, or demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness, or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business in Indiana or elsewhere.

5. Following a review of materials which were submitted in the application, the

Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that they have not fully

met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) and § 27-

1-15.6-12(b)(8), for having a felony conviction of negotiating a bad check and a

misdemeanor conviction of theft on August 23, 2010 in the State of Oregon, and a

misdemeanor conviction of theft on September 9, 2009 in the State of Oregon.

Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the Applicant may, not more than sixty-three

(63) days after notice of denial of the applicant's application is mailed, make written

demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the

reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED

pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) and § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8), due to a having a felony

conviction and two (2) misdemeanor convictions.
