FINAL ORDER


The Indiana Department of Insurance ("Department"), by counsel, Claire Szpara, and Dylan Woods ("Applicant"), signed an Agreed Entry which purports to resolve all issues involved in the above-captioned cause number, and which has been submitted to the Commissioner of Insurance ("Commissioner") for approval.

The Commissioner, after reviewing the Agreed Entry, issuing a resident producer license on a probationary status for two (2) years for having a pending Felony Forgery charge, finds it has been entered into fairly and without fraud, duress or undue influence, and is fair and equitable between the parties. The Commissioner hereby incorporates the Agreed Entry as if fully set forth herein, and approves and adopts in full the Agreed Entry as a resolution of this matter.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Commissioner as follows:

1. Applicant shall be issued a resident license on a probationary period of two (2) years due to a pending criminal case for Felony Forgery under Cause Number 87D02-1507-F4-283 in the Warrick County Superior Court.
2. During the probationary period, and at all time in the future, Applicant shall comply with Indiana Insurance Laws.
3. Applicant must submit the final adjudication of the criminal case to the Department within thirty (30) days after it is issued by the presiding court.
4. The Department reserves the right to seek additional administrative action based on the final adjudication.
5. The Department shall accept Applicant's compliance with the terms of this Final Order as full resolution of this matter.

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AGREED ENTRY

This Agreed Entry is executed by and between the Enforcement Division of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Department"), by counsel, Claire Szpara, and Dylan Woods ("Applicant"), to resolve all issues in the above-captioned cause number. This Agreed Entry is subject to the review and approval of Stephen W. Robertson, Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner").

WHEREAS, on June 14, 2017, Applicant submitted an application for a resident producer's license;

WHEREAS, on license application, Applicant disclosed a March 20, 2015 pending Felony Forgery charge;

WHEREAS, Applicant's conduct is a violation of Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8), which states that the commissioner may place an insurance producer on probation for using

fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest practices, or demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness, or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business in Indiana or elsewhere;

WHEREAS, the Department and Applicant (collectively, the "Parties") desire to resolve this matter without the necessity of a hearing.


IT IS, THEREFORE, NOW AGREED by and between the Parties as follows:

1. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the subject matter and the Parties to this Agreed Entry.
2. This Agreed Entry is executed voluntarily by the Parties.
3. Applicant voluntarily and freely waives the right to a public hearing on the issues in this matter.
4. Applicant voluntarily and freely waives the right to judicial review of this matter.
5. Applicant's license shall be placed on a two (2) year probationary status, during which time any violations of Title 27 of the Indiana Code will result in the Department seeking immediate revocation of Applicant's license.
6. Applicant must submit the final adjudication of the pending felony charge for Cause Number 87D02-1507-F4-283 to the Department within thirty (30) days after it is issued by the presiding court.
7. The Department reserves the right to seek additional administrative action based on the final adjudication of the pending criminal case.
8. The Department agrees to accept Applicant's compliance with this agreement as full satisfaction of this matter.


9. Applicant has carefully read and examined this agreement and fully understands its terms.
10. Applicant has entered into this agreement freely, and has not been subject to duress, threat or undue influence.
11. Should this Agreed Entry not be accepted by the Commissioner, it is agreed that presentation to and consideration of this Agreed Entry by the Commissioner shall not unfairly or illegally prejudice the Commissioner from further participation in or resolution of these proceedings.
12. Applicant is aware that failure to comply with any of the terms of this agreement will result in the matter being set for a hearing.
