ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
NOTICE OF NONRENEWAL OF LICENSE

The Indiana Department of Insurance ("Department"), pursuant to Indiana Code § 4-21.5 *et seq.*, and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Tommy Lee Awbrey, ("Respondent") of the following Administrative Order:

1. Respondent is a licensed resident insurance producer holding license number 983680 since September 23, 2014.
2. Respondent's license expired on June 30, 2017.
3. The Department discovered Respondent had been convicted of misdemeanor Domestic Battery and misdemeanor Battery Resulting in Bodily Injury in Monroe County, Indiana on May 18, 2017.
4. Pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8), the Commissioner may refuse to renew an insurance producer's license for using fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest practices, or

demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness, or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business in Indiana or elsewhere.


5. Pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(2)(A), the Commissioner may refuse to renew an insurance producer's license for violating an insurance law. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-17(b) is an insurance law which states a producer shall report to the Commissioner any criminal prosecution of the producer initiated in any jurisdiction within thirty (30) days after the initial pretrial hearing date.

6. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) requires the Commissioner to notify a licensee of the reason for the nonrenewal of his license. This Order serves as that notice.

7. The Commissioner further notifies Respondent that, pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d), Respondent may, within sixty-three (63) days of the mailing of this Order, make a written demand upon the Commissioner for a hearing to determine the reasonableness of this action. Such a hearing shall be held within thirty (30) days from the date of receipt of Respondent's written demand.

WHEREFORE, based on the foregoing, the Commissioner of Insurance hereby notifies Respondent that **his license shall not be renewed** for having been convicted of misdemeanor Domestic Battery and misdemeanor Battery Resulting in Bodily Injury in violation of Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8), and for failing to report the convictions to the Commissioner within thirty (30) days of the initial pretrial hearing date in violation of Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(2)(A).
