PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance ("Department"), pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Tyler James Marotti ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:

1. Applicant filed an application for licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") on October 6, 2017.
2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the Applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-6 and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12.
3. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) provides that the Commissioner may refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer license for using fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest


practices, or demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business in Indiana or elsewhere.

4. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) provides that the Commissioner may refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer license for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete or materially untrue information in a license application.
5. Following a review of public records, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant he has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Codes §§ 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) and 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) based on Applicant's failure to disclose the following misdemeanor convictions: October 4, 2016 Class A Misdemeanor Operating a Vehicle While Intoxicated; Endangering a Person; November 18, 2013 Class B Misdemeanor Public Intoxication Endangers the Person's Life; June 27, 2012 Class A Misdemeanor Battery and Class B Public Intoxication; December 7, 2011 Class A Misdemeanor Resisting Law Enforcement and Class C Misdemeanor Illegal Consumption of an Alcoholic Beverage
6. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the Applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the Applicant's application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Applicant's request for licensure is hereby
DENIED pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8).
