PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code §4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Steven P. Edick ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:

1. Applicant filed an application for nonresident producer's licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") on September 28, 2017.
2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-8 and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12.
3. Ind. Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) provides that the Commissioner may refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer license due to Applicant having been convicted of a felony.
4. Ind. Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) provides that the Commissioner may refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer license due to using fraudulent, coercive, or

dishonest practices, or demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness, or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business in Indiana or elsewhere.

5. Following a review of materials submitted by Applicant in support of his application, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that he has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) due to his multiple convictions, as follows:

- a. 1995 Narcotics equipment possession or use (1st deg misdemeanor)
- b. 1995 Marijuana possession- not more than 20 g (1st deg misdemeanor)
- c. 1996 Marijuana possession- not more than 20 g (1st deg misdemeanor)
- d. 2004 Felony Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol or Drugs, 3rd offense within 10 years
- e. 2005 Felony Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol or Drugs, 3rd offense within 10 years
- f. 2005 Felony Driving While Suspended with Prior Convictions
- g. 2005 Resisting officer without violence (1st deg misdemeanor)
- h. 2007 Battery- touch or strike (1st deg misdemeanor)

6. Indiana Code §27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the Applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the applicant's application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Applicant's request for licensure is hereby
DENIED pursuant to Indiana Codes §§ 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) and 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8), due to having
three (3) felony convictions and five (5) misdemeanor convictions.
