PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code § 27-1-28-18, hereby gives notice to James Stephenson (“Applicant”) of the following Administrative Order:

1. Applicant filed an application for licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance (“Commissioner”) on November 14, 2017.
2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code § 27-1-28-12 and Indiana Code § 27-1-28-18.
3. Indiana Code § 27-1-28-18(b)(6) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue or renew an independent adjustor license for having been convicted of a felony.
4. Following a review of materials submitted by Applicant in support of his application, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that he has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code § 27-1-28-18(b)(6), because Applicant has been convicted of two (2) counts felony Grand Larceny and Conspire to

Comment Grand Larceny on September 3, 2003 in Rockingham County, Virginia, and felony Possession of Marijuana with Intent to Distribute on July 2, 2007 in Crittenden County, Arkansas.

5. Indiana Code § 27-1-28-18(c) provides that the Applicant may, not more than thirty (30) days after notice of denial of the applicant's application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-28-18(b)(6), due to having been convicted of multiple felony convictions.
