WHEREAS, Respondent is a licensed nonresident insurance producer, holding license number 3282966 since October 13, 2017;

WHEREAS, Respondent negotiated the sale of an Aetna Health Insurance Company product in Indiana on October 06, 2017;

WHEREAS, Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-3(a), is an insurance law that states, in part, that a person shall not sell, solicit, or negotiate insurance in Indiana for any class or classes of insurance unless the person is licensed for that line of authority;

WHEREAS, Respondent's conduct is a violation of Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(2)(A), which states that an insurance producer shall not violate an insurance law; and

WHEREAS, the Department and Respondent (collectively, the "Parties") desire to resolve this matter without the necessity of a hearing.

## IT IS, THEREFORE, NOW AGREED by and between the Parties as follows:

- The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the subject matter and the Parties to this Agreed Entry.
- This Agreed Entry is executed voluntarily by the Parties.
- 3. Respondent voluntarily and freely waives the right to a public hearing on the issues in this matter.
- 4. Respondent voluntarily and freely waives the right to judicial review of this matter.
- Respondent shall pay an administrative fine of Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250)
   within thirty (30) days after the Commissioner signs the Final Order adopting this
   Agreed Entry.
- 6. Should additional violations manifest, further administrative actions will be taken for the new violation(s).
- 7. The Department agrees to accept Respondent's compliance with this agreement as full satisfaction of this matter.
- Respondent has carefully read and examined this agreement and fully understands its terms.
- Respondent has entered into this agreement freely, and has not been subject to duress, threat or undue influence.

- 10. Should this Agreed Entry not be accepted by the Commissioner, it is agreed that presentation to and consideration of this Agreed Entry by the Commissioner shall not unfairly or illegally prejudice the Commissioner from further participation in or resolution of these proceedings.
- 11. Respondent is aware that failure to comply with any of the terms of this agreement will result in the matter being set for a hearing.
