PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Joy Beth Gilley ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:

- Applicant filed an application for nonresident licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") on January 5, 2018.
- 2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-8 and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12.
- 3. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer license for having been convicted of a felony.
- 4. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer license for using fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest

practices, or demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business in Indiana or elsewhere.

5. Following a review of materials submitted by Applicant in support of their application, the

Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that she has not fully

met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) and

Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) due to her October 28, 2005 conviction for Burglary of

a Habitation as a 2nd Degree Felony.

6. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the applicant may, not more than sixty-three

(63) days after notice of denial of the application is mailed, make written demand to the

Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of

the Commissioner's action.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED

pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8).
