
1. The Department served ALJ Hill’s Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Recommended Order and Notice of Filing Recommended Order on Applicant by mailing the same to Applicant.
2. The Department has complied with the notice requirements of Ind. Code § 4-21.5-3-17.
3. On April 18, 2018, the Department filed a timely objection with the Commissioner regarding the Administrative Law Judge’s Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Recommended Order.
4. The ultimate authority shall issue a final order affirming, modifying, or dissolving the administrative law judge’s order per Ind. Code § 4-21.5-3-29.

Therefore, the Commissioner of Insurance, being fully advised, now hereby adopts in full the Administrative Law Judge's Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, and Recommended Order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Commissioner of Insurance:

1. That the Applicant's application for an Indiana Nonresident Producer's License is hereby GRANTED, on a probationary basis, for a period of two (2) years.

Notice is hereby given, pursuant to Indiana Code § 4-21.5-3 *et seq.*, that an evidentiary hearing will be held telephonically on February 7, 2018, at 10:00 ~~A.M.~~ P.M. Eastern Time, at 311 West Washington Street, Suite 103, Indianapolis, Indiana, to determine whether to grant the Applicant's request for approval of her nonresident producer's license.


The hearing will be conducted in accordance with the provisions of the Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, codified at Indiana Code § 4-21.5-3 *et seq.* The Commissioner's authority to deny or refuse to renew an insurance agent's license application is contained in Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b).

The issues to be resolved at the hearing are those described in the Preliminary Administrative Order and Notice of License Denial filed on November 3, 2017.

The Indiana Department of Insurance asserts that Applicant has not fully met the requirements of licensure under Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12 due to having a 3rd Degree Felony

Child Abuse- No Great Harm conviction and a 2015 license denial in the state of Florida, in violation of Indiana Codes §§ 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) and 27-1-15.6-12(b)(9).

In accordance with Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-34, the Administrative Law Judge in this matter is:



**PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER**  
**AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL**


The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Alicia Stephanie Ellick (“Applicant”) of the following Administrative Order:

1. Applicant filed an application for nonresident licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance (“Commissioner”) on October 12, 2017.
2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the Applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-8 and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12.
3. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) provides that the Commissioner may refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer license for having been convicted of a felony.

4. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(9) provides the Commissioner may refuse to issue or renew an insurance producer license for having an insurance producer license, or its equivalent denied, suspended, or revoked in any other state, province, district, or territory.
5. Following a review of materials submitted by Applicant in support of their application, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that she has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) due to having a June 9, 2000 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree Felony conviction of Child Abuse No Great Harm.
6. The Commissioner also hereby notifies Applicant that she has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(9) due to her October 29, 2015 license denial in the state of Florida.
7. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) due to her June 9, 2000 3rd Degree Felony conviction of Child Abuse No Great Harm and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(9) due to her October 29, 2015 license denial in the State of Florida.
