FINAL ORDER


The Enforcement Division of the Indiana Department of Insurance (“Department”), by counsel, Erica J. Dobbs, and Mark McCammon (“Respondent”), a licensed resident insurance producer, signed an Agreed Entry which purports to resolve all issues involved in the above-captioned cause number, and which has been submitted to the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance (“Commissioner”) for approval.

The Commissioner, after reviewing the Agreed Entry, which places Respondent on probation for two (2) years, assesses a civil penalty in the amount of five hundred (\$500) dollars, and requires submission of a corrective action plan for having altered a client’s documents while submitting a claim, finds it has been entered into fairly and without fraud, duress or undue influence, and is fair and equitable between the parties. The Commissioner hereby incorporates the Agreed Entry, attached, as if fully set forth herein, and approves and adopts in full the Agreed Entry as resolution of this matter.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Commissioner as follows:

1. Respondent shall be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years beginning upon execution of this Final Order. During the probationary period, any violations of Title 27 of the Indiana Code will result in the Department seeking immediate revocation of Applicant's license.
2. Respondent shall pay a civil penalty in the amount of five hundred dollars (\$500) dollars within thirty (30) days after the Commissioner executes this Final Order.
3. Respondent shall submit to the Commissioner a corrective action plan describing specific modifications to his business practices to ensure accurate and timely handling of insurance applications and evidences of coverage.

AGREED ENTRY

This Agreed Entry is executed by and between the Enforcement Division of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Department"), by counsel, Erica J. Dobbs, and Mark McCammon ("Respondent") to resolve all issues in the above-captioned cause number. This Agreed Entry is subject to the review and approval of Stephen W. Robertson, Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner").

WHEREAS, Respondent is a resident producer holding license number 2905930 since September 30, 1998;

WHEREAS, the Department was made aware on or about February 12, 2018 that Respondent had been terminated for cause from Erie Insurance for the intentional alteration of a client's documents prior to submitting a claim loss;

WHEREAS, Respondent admits to negligently failing to timely submit a client's insurance application to the company, and then altering the effective date on the policy and claim documents once the client suffered a loss and the application error was discovered;

WHEREAS, Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) states, in part, the Commissioner may levy a civil penalty and place an insurance producer on probation for using fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest practices, or demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness, or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business in Indiana or elsewhere; and


WHEREAS, the Department and Respondent (collectively, the "Parties") desire to resolve this matter without the necessity of a hearing.

IT IS, THEREFORE, NOW AGREED by and between the Parties as follows:


1. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the subject matter and the Parties to this Agreed Entry.
2. This Agreed Entry is executed voluntarily by the Parties.
3. Respondent voluntarily and freely waives the right to a public hearing on the issues in this matter.
4. Respondent voluntarily and freely waives the right to judicial review of this matter.
5. Respondent shall be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years, during which time any violations of Title 27 of the Indiana Code will result in the Department seeking immediate revocation of Applicant's license.
6. The two (2) year probationary period shall begin upon the date of execution of the Final Order in this matter.
7. Respondent shall pay a civil penalty in the amount of five hundred dollars (\$500) to the Department within thirty (30) days after the Commissioner executes the Final Order adopting this Agreed Entry.

8. As a term of his probation, Respondent shall submit to the Commissioner, within thirty (30) days after the Commissioner executes the Final Order adopting this agreed entry, a corrective action plan describing specific modifications to his business practices to ensure accurate and timely handling of insurance applications and evidences of coverage.
9. Should additional violations manifest, this penalty shall be in addition to any administrative actions for the new violation(s).
10. Should this Agreed Entry not be accepted by the Commissioner, it is agreed that presentation to, and consideration of this Agreed Entry by the Commissioner, shall not unfairly or illegally prejudice the Commissioner from further participation in or resolution of these proceedings.
11. Respondent is aware that failure to comply with any of the terms of this agreement will result in the matter being set for a hearing.
