Robertson, Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner").

WHEREAS, Respondent is applying for a resident producer license, with application number 639734;

WHEREAS, Respondent reported on his application an April 24, 2001 conviction for Driving While Suspended, a Class D Felony, and a July 18, 2001 conviction for Theft, a Class A Misdemeanor;

WHEREAS, Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) states, in part, that the Commissioner may place an insurance producer on probation for having been convicted of a felony;

WHEREAS, Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) state, in part, that the Commissioner may place an insurance producer on probation for using fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest practices, or

demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness, or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business in Indiana or elsewhere;

WHEREAS, the Department and Respondent (collectively, the "Parties") desire to resolve this matter without the necessity of a hearing.

IT IS, THEREFORE, NOW AGREED by and between the Parties as follows:

- The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the subject matter and the Parties to this Agreed Entry.
- 2. This Agreed Entry is executed voluntarily by the Parties.
- Respondent voluntarily and freely waives the right to a public hearing on the issues in this matter.
- 4. Respondent voluntarily and freely waives the right to judicial review of this matter.
- 5. Respondent's license shall be granted and placed into probationary status for a period of one (1) year.
- 6. Should additional violations manifest, further administrative actions will be taken for the new violation(s).
- The Department agrees to accept Respondent's compliance with this agreement as full satisfaction of this matter.
- Respondent has carefully read and examined this agreement and fully understands its terms.
- Respondent has entered into this agreement freely, and has not been subject to duress, threat or undue influence.

- 10. Should this Agreed Entry not be accepted by the Commissioner, it is agreed that presentation to and consideration of this Agreed Entry by the Commissioner shall not unfairly or illegally prejudice the Commissioner from further participation in or resolution of these proceedings.
- 11. Respondent is aware that failure to comply with any of the terms of this agreement will result in the matter being set for a hearing.
