PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code § 27-1-28-18, hereby gives notice to Laura Wilkerson (“Applicant”) of the following Administrative Order:

1. Applicant submitted an application for licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance (“Commissioner”) on December 12, 2017.
2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code § 27-1-28-12 and Indiana Code § 27-1-28-18.
3. Indiana Code § 27-1-28-18(b)(6) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue an independent adjuster license for having been convicted of a felony.
4. The Commissioner, being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that she has not fully met the requirements of licensure, as stated by Indiana Code § 27-1-28-18(b)(6), due to having a felony conviction from June 4, 2009 for Operating a Vehicle as a Habitual Traffic Violator; a felony conviction from July 1, 2013 for Operating a Motor Vehicle After

Lifetime Forfeiture of Driving Privileges; and pending felony charges from August 11, 2017 for Operating a Motor Vehicle After Forfeiture of License for Life, all in the State of Indiana.

5. Indiana Code § 27-1-28-18(c) provides that the Applicant may, not more than thirty (30) days after notice of denial of the applicant's application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED pursuant to Indiana Codes §§ 27-1-28-18(b)(6), due to having multiple felony convictions.
