WHEREAS, on his application for licensure, Applicant disclosed a misdemeanor conviction for Residential Entry in Hancock County, Indiana on June 15, 2016;

WHEREAS, Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) states, in part, the Commissioner may place an insurance producer on probation for using fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest practices, or demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness, or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business in Indiana or elsewhere; and

Applicant shall be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years, beginning the date the Commissioner signs the final order adopting this agreed entry, and during which time any violations of Title 27 of the Indiana Code will result in the Department seeking immediate revocation of Applicant's license.
- 6. Should additional violations manifest, this penalty shall be in addition to any administrative actions for the new violation(s).
- 7. The Department agrees to accept Applicant's compliance with this agreement as full satisfaction of this matter.
- 8. Applicant has carefully read and examined this agreement and fully understands its terms.
- Applicant has entered into this agreement freely, and has not been subject to duress,
 threat, or undue influence.

- Should this Agreed Entry not be accepted by the Commissioner, it is agreed that 10. presentation to, and consideration of this Agreed Entry by the Commissioner, shall not unfairly or illegally prejudice the Commissioner from further participation in or resolution of these proceedings.
