FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND RECOMMENDED ORDER

Administrative Law Judge Reuben B. Hill ("ALJ"), having heard, reviewed and considered all of the evidence, will now render a decision concerning the matter of Paidemoyo Charasika ("Respondent"). This matter came on to be heard by the ALJ on June6, 2018 at 11:00 a.m. at the Indiana Department of Insurance at 311 West Washington Street, Indianapolis, Indiana.

The Enforcement Division of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Department") was represented by counsel, Erica J. Dobbs. Respondent failed to appear. Evidence was heard, and exhibits were received into evidence.

Based upon the evidence presented at said hearing, the ALJ now makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and issues the Recommended Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Respondent has been a licensed Non Resident Insurance Producer since March 1, 2004.
- Respondent was previously disciplined by the Department under this cause number for failing to timely disclose two (2) criminal convictions as required by Indiana Code 27-1-15.6-17(b).
- 3. Respondent entered an Agreed Entry to resolve these violations of Indiana Code, agreeing to pay a civil penalty of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) within thirty (30) days of the Commissioner's Final Order accepting the Agreed Entry. The Final Order was entered on November 17, 2017, obligating Respondent to pay the civil penalty no later than December 17, 2017. (Department's Exhibit 1)
- 4. Respondent failed to pay the civil penalty on time.
- 5. On December 20, 2017, the Department reminded Respondent via email of the outstanding monetary obligation. (Department's Exhibit 2)
- 6. On December 21, 2017, the Department offered to allow Respondent to pay the civil penalty in two (2) installments. (Department's Exhibit 2)
- 7. On February 1, 2018, when Respondent had still not satisfied his obligation, the

 Department offered Respondent a six (6) month payment plan and Respondent agreed to

 make the first payment by the end of February. (Department's Exhibit 2)

- 8. As of April 23, 2018, when the Department filed its Statement of Charges, Respondent still had not made any payments toward satisfying the Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00)a civil penalty.
- 9. On April 23, 2018, a hearing was set in this matter for June 6, 2018 and Respondent was notified via U.S. Mail.
- 10. Thereafter, on June 1, 2018, the Department emailed its discovery to Respondent in preparation for the hearing.
- 11. Respondent emailed the Department on Sunday, June 3, 2018 asking what the hearing was regarding, and was informed on June 4, 2018 that the Department was seeking to revoke his license due to his failure to abide by the Commissioner's Final Order of November 17, 2017.
- 12. Respondent emailed the Department on June 6, 2018 seeking a continuance of the hearing. The request was not received until after the hearing began.
- 13. A default hearing was held.
- 14. Conclusions of Law that can be adopted as Findings of Fact are hereby incorporated herein as such.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") has jurisdiction over both the subject matter and the parties to this action.
- 2. This hearing was held in compliance with the Administrative Orders and Procedures Act of the Indiana Code.
- 3. Indiana Code 27-1-15.6-12(b) states, in part, that the Commissioner may permanently revoke an Insurance Producer License, due to a number of factors.

- Specifically, Indiana Code 27-1-15.6-12(b)(2)(D) allows the Commissioner to permanently revoke an Insurance Producer License for violating an order of an insurance commissioner.
- 5. Respondent violated the November 17, 2017 order of the Commissioner by failing to pay the previously agreed upon civil penalty within thirty (30) days.
- 6. Further, the purpose of the civil penalty ordered November 17, 2017, was to resolve Respondents two (2) earlier violations of Indiana Code 27-1-15.6-17(b).
- 7. Respondent's failure to abide by the Commissioner's November 17, 2017 order results in the two (2) violations of Indiana Code 27-1-15.6-17(B) remaining unresolved.
- 8. Indiana Code 4-21.5-3-14 (c) states that the person requesting an agency take action has the burden of persuasion and the burden of going forward. The Department is requesting that the Commissioner permanently revoke Respondent's Resident Producer License.
- 9. The Department has met its burden of showing Respondent violated Indiana Code 27-1-15.6-12(b)(2)(D) and that Respondent's Resident Producer License should be revoked.
- 10. Indiana Code 4-21.5-3-24 states, in part, that if a party fails to attend or participate in a hearing, the administrative law judge may serve upon all parties written notice of a Proposed Default Order, including a statement of the grounds. Within seven (7) days after service of a Proposed Default Order, Respondent may file a written motion requesting the Proposed Default Order not be imposed and stating the grounds relied upon.
- 11. Findings of Fact that can be adopted as Conclusion of Law are hereby incorporated herein as such.

RECOMMENDED ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE RECOMMENDED:

In consideration of the foregoing Findings of Fact and the Conclusions of Law as stated, the Administrative Law Judge now recommends to the **Commissioner of Insurance** the following:

That Respondent's Non Resident Producer License #450648 be permanently
 REVOKED, effective the date the Final Order is issued.
