This Agreed Entry is executed by and between the Enforcement Division of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Department"), by counsel, Erica J. Dobbs, and Angela Petts ("Respondent"), to resolve all issues in the above-captioned cause number. This Agreed Entry is subject to the review and approval of Stephen, W. Robertson, Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner").

WHEREAS, Respondent was a licensed resident insurance producer, holding license number 1511740 since December 5, 1981;

WHEREAS, on or about February 28, 2018, the Department was notified Respondent had been terminated for cause from Transamerica, due to Respondent having submitted applications and/or policy changing documents, with what appeared to be duplicated or inconsistent signatures;

WHEREAS, Respondent's license expired on June 30, 2018;

WHEREAS, on or about July 13, 2018, the Department filed an Order of Nonrenewal against Respondent's producer license due to her termination for cause from Transamerica;

WHEREAS, since the filing of the Order of Nonrenewal, additional evidence has come to light negating and/or mitigating the original allegations against Respondent;

WHEREAS, the Department and Respondent (collectively, the "Parties") desire to resolve this matter without the necessity of a hearing.

IT IS, THEREFORE, NOW AGREED by and between the Parties as follows:

- The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the subject matter and the Parties to this Agreed Entry.
- 2. This Agreed Entry is executed voluntarily by the Parties.
- 3. Respondent voluntarily and freely waives the right to a public hearing on the issues in this matter.
- 4. Respondent voluntarily and freely waives the right to judicial review of this matter.
- 5. The Department shall vacate the Order of Nonrenewal entered against Respondent on July 13, 2018.
- 6. Respondent's license renewal application shall be approved, and Respondent placed on probation for a period of two (2) years, beginning the date the Commissioner enters the Final Order adopting this Agreed Entry.
- 7. During the probationary period any violation of Title 27 of the Indiana Code will result in the Department seeking immediate revocation of Respondent's license.

- 8. Respondent shall take six (6) additional hours of ethics training within the first six (6) months following the date the Commissioner enters the Final Order adopting this Agreed Entry and provide proof of completion to the Department.
- 9. The Department agrees to accept Respondent's compliance with this agreement as full satisfaction of this matter.
- 10. Respondent has carefully read and examined this agreement and fully understands its terms.
- 11. Respondent has entered into this agreement freely, and has not been subject to duress, threat or undue influence.
- 12. Should this Agreed Entry not be accepted by the Commissioner, it is agreed that presentation to and consideration of this Agreed Entry by the Commissioner shall not unfairly or illegally prejudice the Commissioner from further participation in or resolution of these proceedings.
- 13. Respondent is aware that failure to comply with any of the terms of this agreement will result in the matter being set for a hearing.
- 14. Should additional violations manifest, further administrative actions will be taken for the new violation(s).
