## FINAL ORDER

The Indiana Department of Insurance ("Department"), by its counsel Erica J. Dobbs, and Quality Title Insurance Agency, Inc. ("Respondent"), a resident title insurance agency licensed to do business in Indiana, signed an Agreed Entry which purports to resolve all issues involved in the above-captioned cause number, and which has been submitted to the Commissioner of Insurance (the "Commissioner") for approval.

The Commissioner hereby incorporates the Agreed Entry as if fully set forth herein, and approves and adopts in full the Agreed Entry as a resolution of this matter.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Commissioner:

- Respondent shall pay a civil penalty in the amount of nineteen thousand seven hundred fifty dollars (\$19.750) to the Department within thirty (30) days of the date of this Final Order.
- 2. The Department agrees to accept this agreement as full resolution of this matter.

## AGREED ENTRY

This Agreed Entry is executed by the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Department"), by counsel, Erica Dobbs, and Quality Title Insurance Agency, Inc. ("Respondent"), a resident title insurance agency licensed to do business in Indiana, to resolve all issues in the above captioned matter. This Agreed Entry is subject to the review and approval of Stephen W. Robertson, Commissioner, Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner").

WHEREAS, Respondent is a resident title insurance agency holding license number 2800280 since December 5, 1997;

WHEREAS, Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(2)(A) states, in part, that the Commissioner may levy a civil penalty against an insurance producer for violating an insurance law;

WHEREAS, Indiana Code § 6-1.1-12-43(e)(1) is an insurance law requiring that title insurance producers enter real estate transactions into the Residential Real Estate Acquisition of Licensee Information and Numbers Database ("RREAL IN Database") as soon as possible after the closing, and within the time prescribed by the Department;

WHEREAS, the Department has interpreted this to be twenty (20) business days, pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-7-3-15.5(e);

WHEREAS, Respondent failed to enter seven hundred eighty (780) real estate transactions into the RREAL IN Database within the required time period;

WHEREAS, James E. Schaefer, owner of Quality Title Insurance Agency, Inc. is authorized to act on behalf of Respondent and obligate it to perform in accordance with this agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Department and Respondent (collectively, "the Parties") desire to resolve this matter without a hearing.

IT IS, THEREFORE, NOW AGREED by and between the Parties as follows:

- The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the subject matter and the Parties in this Agreed Entry.
- 2. This Agreed Entry is executed voluntarily by the Parties.
- 3. Respondent voluntarily and freely waives the right to a public hearing in this matter.
- 4. Respondent voluntarily and freely waives the right to judicial review of this matter.
- 5. Respondent agrees to pay a civil penalty in the amount of nineteen thousand seven hundred fifty (\$19,750) to the Department within thirty (30) days after the Commissioner signs the Final Order approving this Agreed Entry.
- 6. Should additional violations manifest, this penalty shall be in addition to any administrative actions for the new violation(s).
- 7. The Department agrees to accept Respondent's compliance with the agreement herein as full satisfaction of this matter.

8. Respondent has carefully read and examined this agreement and fully understands its terms.

9. Respondent has entered into this agreement freely, and has not been subject to duress, threat or undue influence.

10. Should this Agreed Entry not be accepted by the Commissioner, it is agreed that presentation to and consideration of this Agreed Entry by the Commissioner shall not unfairly or illegally prejudice the Commissioner from further participation in or resolution of these proceedings.

11. Respondent is aware that failure to comply with any term of this agreement will result in the matter being set for hearing.
