**PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER**  
**AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL**

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to John T. Miller (“Applicant”) of the following Administrative Order:

1. Applicant filed an application for nonresident licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance (“Commissioner”) on June 12, 2018.
2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-8 and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12.
3. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue an insurance producer license for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application.
4. Following a review of materials submitted by Applicant in support of his application and a review of public records, the Commissioner being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that he has not fully met the requirements of licensure as stated by Indiana Code

§ 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) due to his failure to disclose a 2010 Cease and Desist Order issued by the State of Ohio Department of Commerce – Division of Securities, and a 2011 Consent Order issued by the Ohio Department of Insurance.

5. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1), due to his failure to disclose two (2) administrative actions on an application for licensure. Applicant may reapply for licensure not less than one (1) year from the date of this order.
