PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance ("Department"), pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 et seq. and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Shayna Shields ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:

- 1. Applicant submitted an application for licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") on June 10, 2018.
- 2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-8 and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12.
- 3. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue an insurance producer license for having been convicted of a felony.
- 4. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(2)(A) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue an insurance producer license for violating an insurance law. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-17(b) is an insurance law which states that not more than thirty (30) days after an

initial pretrial hearing date, a producer shall report to the commissioner any criminal prosecution of the producer initiated in any jurisdiction.

- 5. Following a review of materials submitted by Applicant in support of her application, the Commissioner, being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that she has not fully met the requirements of licensure, as stated by Indiana Codes 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6), due to Applicant's felony conviction for Wanton Endangerment on March 21, 2016 in the State of Kentucky.
- 6. Following a review of Department records, the Commissioner, being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that she has not fully met the requirements of licensure, as stated by Indiana Codes §§ 27-1-15.6-12(b)(2)(A) and 27-1-15.6-17(b), by failing to timely report criminal charges initiated against her in the State of Kentucky while previously holding Indiana nonresident producer licensure.
- 7. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the Applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the applicant's application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED pursuant to Indiana Codes §§ 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6), 27-1-15.6-12(b)(2)(A), and 27-1-15.6-17(b), due to having a felony conviction and failing to timely report criminal charges initiated while

previously licensed.
