**FINAL ORDER**


The Enforcement Division of the Indiana Department of Insurance (“Department”), by counsel, Erica J. Dobbs, and Keith Grice King (“Applicant”), a nonresident producer applicant, signed an Agreed Entry which purports to resolve all issues involved in the above-captioned cause number, and which has been submitted to the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance (“Commissioner”) for approval.

The Commissioner, after reviewing the Agreed Entry, which grants Applicant a one (1) year probationary nonresident producer license and imposes a two hundred fifty dollar (\$250) civil penalty due to Applicant’s criminal history and the failure to disclose an administrative action by another state on his application for licensure, finds it has been entered into fairly and without fraud, duress or undue influence, and is fair and equitable between the parties. The Commissioner hereby incorporates the Agreed Entry, attached, as if fully set forth herein, and approves and adopts in full the Agreed Entry as a resolution of this matter.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Commissioner as follows:

1. Applicant's nonresident producer license shall be granted and Applicant on probation for a period of one (1) year beginning upon the date of this Final Order.
2. During the probationary period, any violations of Title 27 of the Indiana Code will result in the Department seeking immediate revocation of Applicant's license.

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AGREED ENTRY

This Agreed Entry is executed by and between the Enforcement Division of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Department"), by counsel, Erica J. Dobbs, and Keith Grice King ("Applicant"), to resolve all issues in the above-captioned cause number. This Agreed Entry is subject to the review and approval of Stephen W. Robertson, Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner").

WHEREAS, Applicant submitted an application for nonresident producer licensure on August 7, 2018;

WHEREAS, on said application, Applicant reported criminal charges from 1999 out of the state of Texas, which were resolved by withheld adjudication after Applicant successfully completed seven (7) years supervised probation;

WHEREAS, on said application, Applicant failed to disclose an administrative action taken by the Commissioner of the Oklahoma Department of Insurance which resulted in Applicant being granted a probationary nonresident license in that state due to his criminal history;

WHEREAS, Applicant's conduct is a violation of Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1), which states, in part, that the Commissioner may place an insurance producer on probation and/or

levy a civil penalty against the producer for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application;


WHEREAS, the Department and Applicant (collectively, the "Parties") desire to resolve this matter without the necessity of a hearing.

IT IS, THEREFORE, NOW AGREED by and between the Parties as follows:


1. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the subject matter and the Parties to this Agreed Entry.
2. This Agreed Entry is executed voluntarily by the Parties.
3. Applicant voluntarily and freely waives the right to a public hearing in this matter.
4. Applicant voluntarily and freely waives the right to judicial review of this matter.
5. Applicant's license shall be granted and Applicant placed on probation for a period of one (1) year.
6. During the probationary period, any violations of Title 27 of the Indiana Code will result in the Department seeking immediate revocation of Applicant's license.
7. Applicant shall pay a civil penalty of two hundred fifty dollars (\$250) within thirty (30) days of the Commissioner's final order adopting this agreed entry.
8. Should additional violations manifest, further administrative actions will be taken for the new violation(s).
9. The Department agrees to accept Applicant's compliance with this agreement as full satisfaction of this matter.
10. Applicant has carefully read and examined this agreement and fully understands its terms.

11. Applicant has entered into this agreement freely, and has not been subject to duress, threat or undue influence.
12. Should this Agreed Entry not be accepted by the Commissioner, it is agreed that presentation to and consideration of this Agreed Entry by the Commissioner shall not unfairly or illegally prejudice the Commissioner from further participation in these proceedings.
13. Respondent is aware that failure to comply with any of the terms of this agreement will result in the matter being set for a hearing.

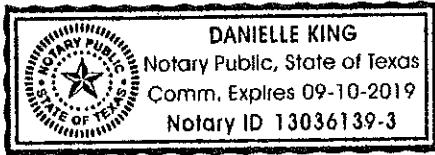
