FINAL ORDER


The Indiana Department of Insurance (“Department”), by its counsel, Erica J. Dobbs, and Jason Parker (“Respondent”), a licensed resident insurance producer, signed an Agreed Entry which purports to resolve all issues in the above-captioned matter, and which has been submitted to the Commissioner of Insurance (“Commissioner”) for approval.

The Commissioner, after reviewing the Agreed Entry, which places Respondent on probation for two (2) years due to Respondent’s conviction for Battery Resulting in Bodily Injury, a Class A Misdemeanor, and Criminal Mischief, a Class B Misdemeanor, and requires Respondent to complete a certified Batterers’ Intervention Program (BIP), finds it has been entered into fairly and without fraud, duress or undue influence, and is fair and equitable between the parties. The Commissioner hereby incorporates the Agreed Entry as if fully set forth herein, and approves and adopts in full the Agreed Entry as a resolution of this matter.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Commissioner of Insurance:

1. Respondent shall be on probation for two (2) years from the date of this Final Order.
2. During the two (2) year probationary period, any violations of Title 27 of the Indiana Code will result in the Department seeking immediate revocation of Respondent's license.
3. Respondent shall successfully complete a certified Batterers' Intervention Program during the term of probation and provide proof of successful completion to the Department.

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AGREED ENTRY

This Agreed Entry is executed by and between the Enforcement Division of the Indiana Department of Insurance (“Department”), by counsel Erica J. Dobbs, and Jason Parker (“Respondent”), a resident insurance producer, to resolve all issues in the above captioned matter. This Agreed Entry is subject to the review and approval of Stephen W. Robertson, Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance (“Commissioner”).

WHEREAS, Respondent is a resident insurance producer licensed to do business in Indiana, holding license number 728377 since November 9, 2010;

WHEREAS, Respondent was charged with Battery Resulting in Bodily Injury to a Child Under 14 Years of Age, a Level 5 Felony, Battery Resulting in Bodily Injury, a Class A Misdemeanor, and Criminal Mischief, a Class B Misdemeanor, in Shelby County, Indiana on April 16, 2018;

WHEREAS, Respondent’s initial hearing on these charges was on April 16, 2018;

WHEREAS, Respondent timely notified the Department of the charges pending against him;

WHEREAS, Respondent was convicted of Battery Resulting in Bodily Injury, a Class A Misdemeanor, and Criminal Mischief, a Class B Misdemeanor, on June 29, 2018;

WHEREAS, Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(8) states, in part, that the Commissioner may revoke a producer's license for using fraudulent, coercive, or dishonest practices, or demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness, or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business in Indiana or elsewhere;

WHEREAS, Respondent has been advised of his right to an administrative hearing before a Department administrative law judge;


WHEREAS, the Department and Respondent (collectively, the "Parties") desire to resolve their differences and settle the issues without the necessity of an administrative hearing.

IT IS THEREFORE NOW AGREED by and between the Parties as follows:

1. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the subject matter and the Parties in this administrative action.
2. This Agreed Entry is executed voluntarily by the Parties.
3. Respondent voluntarily and freely waives his right to a public hearing on this matter.
4. Respondent voluntarily and freely waives his right to judicial review of this matter.
5. Respondent shall be placed on probation for two (2) years, beginning the date of the Commissioner's Final Order adopting this Agreed Entry.
6. During the term of probation, any violations of Title 27 of the Indiana Code will result in the Department seeking immediate revocation of Respondent's license.

7. Respondent agrees to complete a certified Batterers' Intervention Program during the term of probation and provide proof of successful completion to the Department.
8. The Department agrees to accept Respondent's compliance with the terms of this Agreed Entry herein as full satisfaction of this matter.
9. Respondent has carefully read and examined this Agreed Entry and fully understands its terms.
10. Respondent has entered into this Agreed Entry freely, and has not been subject to duress, threat or undue influence.
11. The Department agrees to accept Respondent's compliance with this agreement herein as full satisfaction in this matter.
12. Should this Agreed Entry not be accepted by the Commissioner, it is agreed that presentation to and consideration of this Agreed Entry by the Commissioner shall not unfairly or illegally prejudice the Commissioner from further participation in or resolution of these proceedings.
13. Respondent is aware that failure to comply with any term of this agreement will result in the matter being set for hearing.
