# PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND NOTICE OF CERTIFICATION DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance, pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 *et seq*. and Indiana Code § 27-19-4, hereby gives notice to Mary Roberts ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:

- 1. Applicant submitted an application to become a resident navigator with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") on April 23, 2018.
- 2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code § 27-19-4-3 and Indiana Code § 27-19-4-5.
- 3. Indiana Code § 27-19-4-3(a)(8) provides, in part, that if a person is a navigator, they must not have been convicted of a felony or other crimes determined by the Commissioner.
- 4. The Commissioner, being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that she has not fully met the requirements of licensure, as stated by Indiana Code § 27-19-4-3(a)(8) due to Applicant's convictions for Burglary, a 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree Felony, from June 11, 2011, Criminal

Possession Forged Instrument, a Felony, from June 11, 2011, and Burglary, a 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree Felony, from October 6, 2011, all in the State of Kentucky.

- 5. Should Applicant wish for the Commissioner to review this decision, Applicant must, within fifteen (15) days after receiving notice of this Order, file a written petition with the Commissioner. This petition must state facts demonstrating that Applicant:
  - (A) is a person to whom this Order is specifically directed;
  - (B) is aggrieved or adversely affected by this Order; or
  - (C) is entitled to review under any law
- 6. If a petition for review is granted, the Department shall assign the matter to an administrative law judge to conduct informal proceedings to settle the matter.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED pursuant to Indiana Codes § 27-19-4-3(a)(8), due to Applicant's multiple felony convictions.
